Counseling ministry

God is continuing to use Jasmina's training in Psychology and Christian counseling. Beginning of October, she was in Budapest, Hungary. She worked with YWAM Budapest to help Ukrainian women who are refugees.

At the coffee house she organized art therapy workshop and offered individual counseling. It was hard to listen some of their stories (especially since some women have husbands who are in the army) but it was a blessing to be able to do this and in a small way offer support and encouragement.

Prayer requests:

- Please continue to pray for Ukraine: for peace, for God's mercy, protection and provision. The destruction of houses and power stations (nearly 30%) by Russian attacks is especially hard as the winter is approaching and people may not be able to heat their houses. Igor's mom is still with us in France and we are grateful for that.
- Please pray for all the seeds that have been sown through different opportunities we had, here in our neighborhood, in Aix-En-Provence, and in Budapest.
- Pray for Jasmina as she has another opportunity to serve last weekend of November in Mostar, Bosnia. With another 2 Christian psychologist she will be leading weekend seminar about Self-care and offer individual counseling. Seminar is organized by the local church but is open to everyone from community.
- For Duncan family with whom we have been serving together in France for the past 10 years. They are moving back to US. We are excited for the next chapter God has in their lives but it is hard for us to say goodbye. Their daughter Isla and our daughter Mila are best friends since birth (both were born in France).
